ROYAL RANGERS ALUMNI OBJECTIVES "Continuing To Serve"

- A method by which retired RR leaders may continued to serve as vital part of the Royal Rangers Ministry.
- A method by which you can share your knowledge and experiences with the boys and leaders as your time permits.
- A method by which you determine the amount of time you wish to give the Ranger Ministry.
- To provide an opportunity for service and ministry for "retired" Royal Ranger leaders.
- To fellowship with current and former Royal Ranger leaders.
- Serve as a resource to the leadership at the local church through national level.
- To remember and minister to retired Royal Rangers leaders and their spouse during time of need.

RRA MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

- Be 55 years old or medically unable to carry out the duties of a regular commander .
- Be in good standing with his or her church and their district.
- Has served in a Royal Ranger position at the local level or higher.
- Approved by District RRA Coordinator for membership.
- Dual membership: leaders serving in a position within a chartered outpost (or higher) and a RRA member.

Note: some leaders may have reached the eligibility age however they desire to continue to serve in their assigned position and still participate in RRA
