The National Royal Rangers Center is located in southwest Missouri and in the heart of the Mark Twain National Forest. An easy drive from Kansas, Oklahoma, and Arkansas, and many other surrounding states would be able to 'drop by' with a little planning ahead. Not far from Tulsa, northwest Arkansas, and Springfield/Branson airports. Camp Eagle Rock is nestled in a beautiful valley and surrounded by gentle rolling hills, with seasonal creeks throughout. It is also near the famous Table Rock Lake as well as other nearby lakes. Other special interest areas to visit within a short drive are Roaring River State Park, Eureka Springs, Branson, Silver Dollar City, and much, much more! The campground has about 1,500 acres of native and planned camping. Camp Eagle Rock is the site of our National Royal Rangers Camporama every fourth year.

On site we have hiking, a bouldering wall, high ropes course, BMX course, mountain bike course, rappelling tower, archery and rifle range, huge meadows for various activities, and swimming pools. Of course, some of these activities are seasonal and others may require special arrangements for instructors or counselors to be on site for your health and safety. Plenty of other opportunities are available nearby, such as canoeing, boating, swimming, fishing, and caving or spelunking.

In the Johnnie Barnes Lodge, we have a huge conference room for your meetings and banquets and a large fireplace to enjoy on the cool evenings. The full-length front porch has rocking chairs to relax in while viewing the pristine acres of meadows and mountains to the south. A full service kitchen is available to prepare those meals for your hungry campers. There are 4 upstairs bedrooms with 2 bunk beds in each room that will sleep up to 16 campers. Each room has a full bathroom. These 4 bedrooms have heating and air conditioning and a great over view of the campground. The basement of the lodge has 11 bunk beds and will sleep a maximum of 22 people. There is also a large bathroom with showers connected to this room. All overnight guests in the lodge must have an assigned bed. Sleeping in the conference room is not allowed.

Near Fort Hughes is Deaverton, the western town with 8 bunkhouses that have 2 bunk beds in each for a fun campout. If your group is more of the "primitive" type, you may want to reserve the raised floor Platform Tents with cots that sleep 2 people. Several are available. Fort Hughes also has a very nice council fire area with bench seating. Of course, there are those of you who may really want to "go camping" and choose to bring your own tents and pay for choice campsites with a restroom/shower house nearby.

For more modern comforts, you may choose the Eagles Resort. The Eagles Lodge has a large meeting room, restrooms/showers, and a kitchen. This facility also has 7 cabins with 2 rooms each. They all have their own shower room, bathroom, and 2 sinks. Six of the cabins offer 12 rooms with 1 queen bed and 2 bunk beds in each room allowing for 5 or 6 persons per room for a total of 72 campers. The Staff Cabin has two rooms with 1 queen bed and 1 bunk bed in each. It is available for camp staff members, counselors, families, or special guest speakers. Adding the beds in the Staff Cabin, the total number of campers is 78. All cabins and the meeting room have heat and air conditioning. There are also 5 full hookup RV sites and primitive camping nearby. This is an excellent facility for just under 100 campers. Consider the Eagles Resort for your next retreat, youth camp, couples retreat, seminar, or conference. An outdoor council fire ring is also within walking distance.

We do not furnish linens. Please clean the areas you have used, inside and out, including buildings, prior to your leaving. You must have a "check out inspection" with a Camp Eagle Rock staff member before you leave the site, or your cleaning deposit may not be approved for refund.
